

## ADA Professional Publications: Migration Checklist

### Before Launch (to be completed before November 30, 2021)

- Confirm your journal entitlements.** [Access your account information](#) from an IP registered to your institution, and please note what content you have access to on the current HighWire platform so you can confirm you have access on the new Silverchair platform. We will send out another email when we are ready for you to review information on the new platform.
- Prepare for link resolver, URL, discovery layer, and ERM changes.** Please note that the subdomains for the journal sites will change, as follows:
  - The URL for *Diabetes* will change from [diabetes.diabetesjournals.org](http://diabetes.diabetesjournals.org) (current Highwire platform) to [diabetesjournals.org/diabetes](http://diabetesjournals.org/diabetes) (new Silverchair platform)
  - The URL for *Diabetes Care* will change from [care.diabetesjournals.org](http://care.diabetesjournals.org) to [diabetesjournals.org/care](http://diabetesjournals.org/care)
  - The URL for *Clinical Diabetes* will change from [clinical.diabetesjournals.org](http://clinical.diabetesjournals.org) to [diabetesjournals.org/clinical](http://diabetesjournals.org/clinical)
  - The URL for *Diabetes Spectrum* will change from [spectrum.diabetesjournals.org](http://spectrum.diabetesjournals.org) to [diabetesjournals.org/spectrum](http://diabetesjournals.org/spectrum)

Examine your system's requirements. Will updates to records occur through an automated process through your vendor, or do you need to deactivate any old records and activate new records? Do you need to manually update the URLs listed above? The ADA will contact vendors and agencies, including EBSCO, Ovid, and ProQuest.

- Gather usage statistics.** Pull all historic usage statistics. Only two years of historical usage data (as a ZIP file) will be available on the new platform post-launch. Future data will be available as COUNTER 5 data on a monthly basis, as usual.
  - Please note that Highwire will be able to export only COUNTER 4 data, so the ZIP file will only contain COUNTER 4 usage. If you would like COUNTER 5 data from Highwire, please download your reports before the end of November.
- Sign up for PSI's IP Registry.** With the launch of the Silverchair platform, ADA entitlements will be integrated with [PSI's IP Registry](#). The IP Registry provides a central repository for librarians to update and manage their IPs for multiple publisher platforms. If you have not already signed up for the IP Registry, please consider doing so.

## Launch Day (December 15, 2021)

On launch day, the content will propagate throughout the day. We will be in touch with more information prior to the launch date.

## Immediately After Launch

- Verify you have access.** All current customers will have grace access to all ADA journal content until January 14, 2022. You will have the opportunity to verify access to purchased entitlements when this grace period ends. To initiate access to your entitlements on the new platform, you will need to utilize the “reset password” link and authenticate onto the site upon your initial account set-up. Access to a given account will be based on the email address associated with the account.

## Post-Launch

- Pull usage reports from the Silverchair platform beginning with December 2021 reports.** The new Silverchair platform will begin collecting usage after its launch in early December. In January 2022, we will populate the Silverchair platform with Highwire-related usage reports for November and early December 2021. We ask for your patience while we work to ensure the reports are properly loaded.
- Verify your library administration account information.** After launch, check your IPs and identify your proxy IP address, contact information, username, and email address. Please be sure to update your SUSHI APIs with the new values for the Silverchair platform.
- Update usage statistics links.** The login to view usage statistics will change. We will be in touch with instructions after the launch with the new links and information on how to access your usage statistics.
- Enable SUSHI reporting.** Please be sure to update your SUSHI APIs with the new values for the Silverchair platform.
- Verify your access to purchased entitlements.** When the grace period ends on January 14, 2022, please verify that you have access to your purchased entitlements.
